**Latin Name:** Dendroica Virens

**Bird's Habitat:** Forest edges

**Interesting Facts:**

- The wing span of the bird is 17-20 cm.
- Their weight is 7-11 gm.
- They can be found in the US, Canada, Mexico, Colombia, and Venezuela.
- In the summer, the birds migrate to the Great Lake Regions, Appalachians, and New England.
- Other than eating insects, the birds will occasionally eat berries during migration and the winter.
- The birds usually lays 3-5 eggs.
- They are small birds, but they are very active.
- During the fall, the birds' wing tips turn yellow.
- They are about 4.25 inches long.
- They have thin pointy bills for eating insects.
